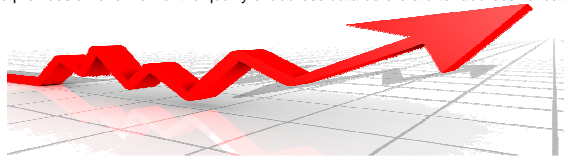
Based on a DM campaign we have identified upto 50,510 records that may not be suitable for mailing  
If we make an assumption that each pack is worth £1 on average this equates to a waste of £50,510 for each mailing

Additionally to the cost saving, there is also your adherence to data protection principles in order to "keep clean"  
your database (through effective use of suppressions), and remove those that do not wish to receive DM.  
Coupled with cleansed and deduplicated data this will enhance your customers experience with your communications

#### Notes

Codes A through to C inclusive are PAF matches, this equates to 51,217 records which is 45% of the data supplied.

Codes D through to F inclusive are those that have significant elements of the address, however could not be found on the PAF file. This accounts for 18,887 records (17%)

Codes G onwards are generally not recommended to be mailed. This is due to significant key elements of the address not being able to be identified within the data supplied.

Before processing the number of mailable records were 47,487 which is 42% and after processing it becomes 70,104 which is 62% that is a change of 22,617 records
